

BRISBANE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES ARRANGMENTS AND OTHER LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL 2024

Short title

The short title of the Bill is the Brisbane Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements and Other Legislation Amendment Bill.

Policy objectives and the reasons for them

The purpose of the amendment is to ensure that submissions made to the Truth-telling and Healing Inquiry by Queenslanders are able to be shared with Queenslanders.

Achievement of policy objectives

To achieve these objectives, amendments are proposed to various clauses as outlined below.

Alternative ways of achieving policy objectives

There are no known alternate ways of achieving the same policy objective.

Estimated cost for government implementation

There are no known costs as the documents will be tabled in the Queensland Parliament like any other tabled document.

Consistency with fundamental legislative principles

The amendments are consistent with fundamental legislative principles.

Consultation

Discussions occurred with Queensland community members.

Consistency with legislation of other jurisdictions

The legislation and policy intent are specific to Queensland.

Notes on provisions

Amendment 1 amends Clause 26 of the Bill to insert a new provision to require any submission made to the Truth-telling and Healing Inquiry to be provided to the Clerk of the Parliament for tabling in the Queensland Parliament on behalf of all Queenslanders.
