Crime and Corruption Commission funding proposal

I write on behalf of the Justice, Integrity and Community Safety Committee (committee) to report on the committee's review of a funding proposal submitted by the chief executive officer of the Crime and Corruption Commission.

On 27 February 2025, the committee received a funding proposal from the chief executive officer of the Crime and Corruption Commission to defer \$9 million of 2024-25 budget allocation to 2025-26 and the forward estimates to 2029-30 to progress a range of digital transformation projects.

Under the *Crime and Corruption Act 2001*, the committee must review the funding proposal and prepare a report in consultation with the appropriate officers of Queensland Treasury.

In preparing the report of its review of the funding proposal, the committee consulted with appropriate officers of Queensland Treasury and had regard to the rationale for the funding proposal presented by the Crime and Corruption Commission. The committee resolved to **approve the chief executive's funding proposal**.

The committee notes the *Crime and Corruption Act 2001* requires that the Minister table the committee's report in the Legislative Assembly, along with a report setting out the Minister's response to the proposal, after the Minister's response has been implemented.
